Infographic competition

Infographic portrayal of the hazards / impact of mine dust on a local community. The infographic should provide information that can educate the community on the exposure risks, health effects, preventive measures and potential mitigation of mine dust impacts.

Prize

The prize money is **R5 000**. **Winners will be announced on the 30th of April 2021 via the network website and other social media platforms.**

Eligibility

1. This competition is open to everyone with the exception of members of the GCRF Mine Dust & Health Network steering committee and their immediate families.
2. The contest starts on **7 February 2021 and closes at 23:59 on 31 March 2021**. The individual who will submit the infographic shall be considered as the contestant and will be the only person eligible to compete for and claim the prize.

How to Enter:

1. Design an infographic addressing the topic mentioned above. Infographics submitted must be your own original work.
2. E-mail your entry to talktous@minedust.org with the subject **“Impact of mine dust in a community I know”** no later than **31 March 2021**, at midnight. Please ensure that your infographic has a separate cover page with your full names and contact details. The infographic itself should not bare any author details but should contain the GCRF and mine dust network logos. In the event that your entry is received and accepted, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to you. Should you receive no confirmation, contact talktous@minedust.org for details on re-submission.
3. Only one submission will be accepted per person. That submitted infographic will be considered as the final submission and you may not edit, modify, or replace it. Your

submitted file should not exceed **5MB** each. Entry into this competition is automatically deemed as acceptance of these official competition rules and consent to the use of the infographics by the GCRF Mine Dust & Health Network for purposes the network deems fit.

Selection of Winners: Judging Criteria

The infographics will be adjudicated by a panel of judges whose **decision is final**.

The criteria for judging in order of importance are:

1. Effectiveness in raising awareness about the impact of mine dust on communities
2. Design: Visual appeal
3. Content quality: Data validity and accuracy as presented in the infographic
4. Potential for knowledge transfer: Ability to convey complex topics in an easy to understand format
5. Originality: Innovation in presented content
6. Discussion generating potential: catchy, engaging and “lingering effect”

Content Requirements

Entries should not:

- Be offensive i.e. be sexually explicit or suggestive, or derogatory of any ethnic, racial, gender, religious, professional or age group or the disabled, be pornographic, or contain nudity.
- Promote any substance abuse, any unsafe or dangerous practices, or any particular political agenda or message.
- Defame, misrepresent or contain disparaging remarks with respect to other people or organizations.
- Contain any prominent use of trademarks, logos or trade dress that may be deemed as marketing, or contain any personal identification details, such as license plate numbers, personal names, e-mail addresses or street addresses.
- Contain any materials with copyrights owned by others (including artworks, photographs, or images published on or in websites, television, movies or other media).
- Have content that relates to the names, photographs, resemblances, or other indicia identifying any person, living or dead without consent;

- Communicate messages or images inconsistent with the positive images and/or goodwill to GCRF Mine Dust & Health Network wishes to associate;
- Portray and or itself be in contravention of any law or legislative framework.
- Depict or otherwise show a minor without parental or legal guardian consent.
